

THE BARTONVILLE TOWN COUNCIL HELD A SPECIAL MEETING ON THE 14th DAY OF MAY 2019, AT BARTONVILLE TOWN HALL, 1941 E. JETER RD, IN THE TOWN OF BARTONVILLE, COUNTY OF DENTON, TEXAS AT 6:30 P.M.

A. CALL SPECIAL MEETING ORDER

Mayor Scherer called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

B. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Scherer led the pledge of allegiance.

C. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION/CITIZEN APPEARANCES

There were none.

D. CANVASS OF MAY 4, 2019, GENERAL AND SPECIAL ELECTIONS, CERTIFICATES OF ELECTION AND OATHS OF OFFICE

1. Consider approval of a resolution canvassing returns and declaring the results of the general and special elections held May 4, 2019, for the purpose of electing three Councilmembers Places, 1, 3, and 5, for two-year terms each; and electing Councilmember Place 4 for the unexpired term ending May 2020.

Town Secretary Tammy Dixon stated the general and special elections were held on Saturday, May 4, 2019, with 277 ballots cast in the election, of which, 2 were cast absentee, 172 were cast early, and 103 were cast on election day.

Mayor Scherer presented the Certificates of Election and administered the Oaths of Office to newly elected councilmembers Clay Sams and Bridget Melson.


F. ADJOURNMENT


