From the Mayor

Warm Greetings from Bartonville, I hope you had a very Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year!

Once again, Bartonville residents made sure that the Town's annual Blue Santa program was an unquestionable success. In our 6th year of the program, the generosity of our residents allowed for every child that registered for the program to receive gifts and have a special Christmas. Thank you to everyone who supported this important community program. The continued compassion from our citizens is humbling. A special THANK YOU to the teachers and students of Argyle High School Student Leadership for taking the time to wrap all the presents and donations received.

The Town has completed repaving Rockgate Road and Dove Creek Road from Gibbons to Noble Champions. There will be even more progress made on our roads this summer. In addition to our annual maintenance, we are currently in the design process for repaving 15 roads this summer. The total improvement in linear feet of new pavement will be approximately 12,900 feet. These large-scale projects are a part of a 20-year plan that the Council and I crafted last year with input and guidance from the Town Engineer. Over the next 20 years, the Town will be investing over \$8,000,000 into our roads.

Many of you have noticed the construction on FM407, by Marty-B's. The 7-Eleven convenience store previously located in the Bartonville Town Center has expanded, moved and is now open for business! It is now a gas and convenience store, located on the southwest corner of FM 407 & I.T. Neely.

General Election

The Town of Bartonville will hold a General Election on Saturday, May 4, 2019, for the purpose of electing three Councilmembers Places 1, 3 and 5.

Councilmembers are elected "at-large," each representing the entire community and serve two-year terms.

Candidates interested in filing an application for a place on the ballot can download an application from the town's website or obtain one from Town Hall. Applications may be filed Monday through Friday beginning January 16, 2019, and must be received by 5:00 p.m. February 15, 2019, at Town Hall, 1941 E. Jeter Road, Bartonville, Texas 76226. Town Hall office hours are 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.

Medication Disposal Unit

Bartonville Citizens now have a safe way to dispose of unwanted medication. CVS/pharmacy donated a Medication Disposal Unit to the Bartonville Police Department. The unit is installed in the front lobby of the police department.



Bring your unwanted or expired prescriptions and drop them in the unit. It's the safest and most responsible way to dispose of medication. The unit will accept prescription patches, medications, ointments, OTC medications, vitamins, samples and medication for pets. The unit will not accept needles, inhalers, aerosol cans, liquids, lotions, or thermometers.
