May 5, 2018 General Election



The Town of Bartonville will hold a General Election on Saturday, May 5, 2018, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and two Councilmembers Places 2 and 4.

Councilmembers are elected "at-large," each representing the entire community and serve two-year terms.

Candidates interested in filing an application for a place on the ballot can download an application from the town's website or obtain one from Town Hall. Applications may be filed Monday through Friday beginning January 17, 2018, and must be received by 5:00 p.m. February 16, 2018, at Town Hall, 1941 E. Jeter Road, Bartonville, Texas 76226. Town Hall office hours are 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.

Residents are able to sign up for the "Notify Me" notification email and text messaging system, which informs subscribers when new information is posted on the website. When residents sign-up for this notification, they have the opportunity to subscribe to a variety of alerts including various categories within the Agenda Center, Calendar, News Flash, and Alert Center, and receive email notifications or SMS (text) messages.

Once the information is posted to the Town's website and a notification is sent, it is immediately distributed to those who have signed-up.

The current notification system will be phased out by February 28, 2018.

Open Burning in Bartonville

The disposal of vegetation by open burning is permitted in Bartonville but ONLY on a day that has been determined to be a "good burn day by the Denton County Fire Marshall." The burn day status is determined each morning between 8:00 and 9:00 a.m.

When registering your burn you will be asked for a permit number, please state that you are within the Town limits of Bartonville and no permit is required.

Medication Disposal Unit

Bartonville Citizens now have a safe way to dispose of unwanted medication. CVS/pharmacy donated a Medication Disposal Unit to the Bartonville Police Department. The unit is installed in the front lobby of the police department.



Bring your unwanted or expired prescriptions and drop them in the unit. It's the safest and most responsible way to dispose of medication. The unit will accept prescription patches, medications, ointments, OTC medications, vitamins, samples and medication for pets. The unit will not accept needles, inhalers, aerosol cans, liquids, lotions, or thermometers.
